

2011 Miss Gibson County Fair

Ages 16-20, Girls Only

Saturday, August 27th, 11:00 a.m. Contestant Interviews begin @ 9:30. (Contestants only)

1. Entry fee is \$30 per contestant. NO CHECKS! CASH or MONEY ORDER ONLY!
2. The contestant must have reached her 16th birthday, but not her 21st birthday by December 31, 2011.
3. The contestant cannot qualify if she has ever been married, had a child, or found guilty of a felony. The contestant must currently and have always been of the female gender.
4. Gown must be formal and floor length. No exposed midriff allowed. Contestants are not allowed to carry flowers during the judging of the contest.
5. All contestants in the 2011 Miss Gibson County Fair Pageant must attend practice on Friday, August 26th, from 6:30-7:30 p.m. Deadline for registration will be at 6:30 p.m. August 26th due to the fact contestants must draw for their interview times which begin @ 9:30 Saturday morning. If not registered by this date and time you may not enter. We will not allow late entries at the door the day of the pageant.
6. Interviews will be held on Saturday morning, August 27th; at 9:30 a.m., Interview Times will be given to all contestants at practice Friday, August 26th. Attire should consist of a dress or business type suit for interviews.
7. Judging will consist of 50% beauty and 50% interview.
8. **Must be a resident of Gibson, Crockett, or Weakley Counties. (We reserve the right to ask for proof of address)**
9. Miss Gibson County Fair must compete in the State Fairest of the Fair competition in Nashville and be present for the Convention January 19th-21st 2012. (Contestant may participate in the State Pageant only one time.) The Gibson County Fair Association will pay for the room and entry fee for the Queen only. All of Miss Gibson County Fair's friends and family will be responsible for purchasing in advance State Pageant and Banquet Tickets. If the 2010 Miss Gibson County Fairest of the Fair does not participate in the State Fairest of the Fair competition in January of 2011 she will be responsible for reimbursing the Gibson County Fair Association all entry fees to the State Fairest of the Fair Competition, Pageant and Banquet tickets purchased and the room fees that were paid for the Queen and any deposits or pre-payments made by the Gibson County Fair Association on behalf of the Queen's family and friends.
10. Miss Gibson County Fair will be eligible to compete in the Strawberry Festival parade and Territorial Revue in Humboldt. The Gibson County Fair will not be responsible for cart/wagon/ float etc. or any fees associated with participation in the Strawberry Festival Parade or Territorial Review.
11. As a representative of the fair, the 2011 Miss Gibson County Fairest of the Fair must participate at the Jr. Market Livestock Show by handing out ribbons Monday, August 29th at 10 a.m., opening ceremonies Monday August 29th @ 6:00 p.m., and participate at the Mud Bog on Friday and the Tractor Pull on Saturday. The Fair asks the Queen to participate in helping on the fairgrounds during the week of the fair. Ex: helping with other pageants, working in the café, or helping in the barn
12. If, for some reason, she cannot complete the aforementioned rules, she will relinquish all rights (crown, banner, scepter and/or trophy) as 2011 Miss Gibson County Fair and the first maid will therein become Queen.
13. A contestant may not represent more than one fair in any given year.
