Youth Division General Rules

1. Youth exhibitors include students who are in attendance in any grade or high school located in Gibson, Weakley or Crockett Counties who have finished high school in the spring prior to the fair.
2. Items or articles entered in any class of the Junior Division must have been made by the person in whose name it is entered.
3. Any entry borrowed, purchased or entered incorrectly shall be disqualified for judging.
4. No entries will be accepted unless listed in the project choices.
5. **Exhibitor may enter only one item per lot.**
6. Items must have been made since the last fair and cannot have been exhibited before at the Gibson County Fair.
7. Please see project categories for additional specific project related rules.
8. Every effort will be made to protect exhibits, however, Fair Association will not be responsible for damaged or missing exhibits.

Youth Awards

All classes will be judged with premium not to exceed \$3-blue group; \$2-red group; \$1-white group; and Best of Show. Best of Show rosette and cash will be given in the following categories: clover bud projects, sewing, misc. youth projects, photography, make it-take it crafts, junior art, culinary, canning, garden, crops and horticulture.

\$100 prize will be given to the boy & the girl exhibitor who has the most entries in the Youth Division.

Drop off times for youth projects

Art, make it-take it crafts, canning, miscellaneous youth projects, sewing, crops, garden, culinary, horticultural projects, flower arrangements and photography must be brought in on **Sunday, August 28th between 1-5 p.m.** You must have an exhibitor number and entry sheet filled out with your name, address, and lot numbers of your entries. The sheet must be turned in to a fair official or a fair volunteer before you leave the building!

Pick up times for youth projects

All entries must be picked up between 2-4 p.m. Sunday, Sept. 4th. If you do not pick up your projects, they will be taken to the University of Tennessee Extension Office at 1252 Manufacture's Row, Trenton, TN (731-855-7656). If your items are not picked up within two weeks after the fair, they will be disposed of.

Premium checks will be given out on Sunday, September 4th, 2-4 P.M.
